Collects, compiles, edits, verifies and submits various required environmental data and reports; ensures the accuracy of various required environmental data; inspects the facilities to ensure compliance with applicable regulations, rules and permits and assists company personnel in responding to environmental and safety concerns.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Keeps regional facilities in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local environmental and safety laws, standards, and permits and has responsibility for maintaining current permit status.
- Oversees and evaluates safety and health programs and ensures compliance to federal, state and local safety and health regulations
- Monitor safe work practices
- Analyzes data on safety performance; develops and supports improvement countermeasures
- Compliance auditing
- Supervises emergency response procedures and implementation including security response
- Security program management and auditing
- Provides first line immediate environmental emergency responses to incidents, spills, releases, and accidents.
- Provides appropriate notifications to management and appropriate regulatory agencies and assists with site investigations and remediation projects related to due diligence activities and other environmental issues
- Counsels, advises and trains production personnel on the scope of all current environmental regulations. Assists production personnel in the timely solution to environmental regulatory violations or problems
- Compiles environmental operating data for transmittal to various governmental agencies
- Facilities Response Plan management
- Facility Security Plan management
- Management of all required licenses and permits
